1. **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Animals will be received Thursday after 12 noon, October 15 or Friday morning, October 16, by noon and released Saturday, October 17, following the show.

2. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Each horse must have a Negative Coggins test within 12 months of the show date. If coming out of state and Interstate Health Certification must meet the requirements of the State of Georgia.

3. Early entries must be **RECEIVED** by September 15, 2015. Your **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** and **SIGNATURE** are **REQUIRED** on your Entry Form.

4. **AGE** of animals is to be based on January 1 of each year.

5. **SHOW CONDITION:** Each animal must be in show condition and deemed worthy by the judge to receive premiums.

6. **PROPER DRESS:**

a. **Halter Classes:** Exhibitors as well as helpers will be required to be in proper show dress while in the show ring. **(NO BLUE JEANS or SHORTS).**

b. **Performance Classes:** Men: Sport Coat & Tie
Ladies: Dressy dress, long skirt & blouse or pants suit (Hat & Gloves optional).

c. **Under Saddle:** (1)Western: Western show shirt or blouse, show pants (blue jeans allowed), western hat; (Vest, chaps optional)

(2) English: Complete show attire according to the discipline.

7. **HALTER CLASSES:** ALL MARES and STALLIONS must be registered with their respective breed's association and registration number **MUST** be on the Entry Form to enter class.

8. **JUNIOR DRIVERS:** must be accompanied by an adult in all Junior Driving Classes.

9. **OBSTACLE COURSES** and rules will be available when signing for those classes and will be posted at the Show Office.

10. **SPORTSMANSHIP:** Any unsportsmanlike conduct by an exhibitor will disqualify both exhibitor and horse from the show.

11. **GA BRED & OWNED:** Entrant must be a Georgia resident who owned the dam at time of breeding and currently owns the offspring.

12. **BE ON TIME** for each class you have entered.

a. the show ring gate will be closed after five (5) minutes or a third call by Ringmaster, ****Exhibitor will not be allowed to enter the ring.**

b. If you wish to withdraw from a class, please let the Ringmaster and/or the Bookkeeper know in advance so the class will not be held up. **(**Note: There is no refund of class fees)**

13. **INTERFERENCE WITH JUDGE:** The judge shall report to the management any exhibitor or exhibitors who in any way, whether in person or by agents or employees, interfere with him during his adjudication or manifest any disrespect to him, whereupon a proper apology from such exhibitor shall be demanded. Any exhibitor who refuses to comply with this rule may be excluded from further competition and the management may withhold from such exhibitor any premiums that may have been awarded to him.

14. The show committee reserves the right to add, delete, or combine classes as the committee deems necessary.

15. All horses must be tied in the wash rack.

16. No youth exhibitor may show a stallion in ANY class.

17. Any entry **excused for any reason** during a class will forfeit placing & prize money.

18. **LIABILITY:** The Georgia National Fair & Agricenter and the Georgia Draft Horse Association, specifically, jointly or severally, assume no liability or responsibility whatsoever for any damages or injuries to animal or person and/or loss of equipment. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their animals. Unruly animals may be dismissed.

19. **PARKING & PASSES:** All vehicles pulling trailers with horses aboard will be allowed to enter the East Gate.

Vehicle and admission passes will be issued upon arrival at the barn when stalling horses. One complimentary vehicle pass and two complimentary admission passes will be issued per exhibitor and must be picked up at the barn. Vehicles with vehicle passes may park in Lots 5 or 6. All other vehicles must park outside gates and all other personnel must purchase admission tickets at gate. When leaving the grounds, be sure to have your hand stamped at the gate to be able to return the same day at no charge.

Attention - All Youth Draft Horse Exhibitors!

Georgia National Fair, Perry, GA - October 16-17, 2015

This will be a Hi-Point type competition for all Youth Exhibitors. There is no enrollment required for this award. Every Youth that competes (with any horse/team) in any combination of the following five classes is eligible and will be automatically entered:

**Youth Showmanship (in either age category) - Youth Under Saddle English
Youth Under Saddle Western - Youth Cart - Youth Team**

The Points will be counted as follows: 1st – 10 Points, 2nd – 9 Points, 3rd – 8 Points, 4th – 7 Points, 5th – 6 Points, 6th – 5 Points, 7th – 4 Points, 8th – 3 Points, 9th – 2 Points, 10th – 1 Point, all remaining exhibitors 1 point each. In the event of a tie for any of the places – the youth with the greatest number of 1st places will be the winner. If a tie remains, it will go to the youth with the greatest number of 2nd places, and so on.

All Youth exhibitors will be called to the Show Ring Saturday Night when the results have been tallied after all the youth classes have completed. There, a Memorial for Pia will be read out by our announcer, the results will be announced and the awards will be presented to the winners and all youth exhibitors.

There will be Five Places Awarded: **1st Place - \$350.00, Trophy, & GNF Medal**

2nd Place - \$250.00 & GNF Medal

3rd Place - \$150.00 & GNF Medal

4th Place - \$100.00 & GNF Medal

5th Place - \$50.00 & GNF Medal

with a GNF Medal given out to every remaining youth exhibitor.
